

ORDINANCE NO. 3388
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A CERTAIN ORDINANCE WHICH ESTABLISH THE
SALARIES FOR VARIOUS CITY EMPLOYEES TO BE PAYABLE COMMENCING THE
FIRST PAY IN JANUARY 2004

WHEREAS, this Council passed Ordinance 3365 which established the salaries for various employees of the City of New Castle, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there should be certain adjustments relative to the salaries and positions established.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE that Ordinance Number 3365 be amended:

Section I.

1. Ordinance Number 3365 shall be amended as follows:

- A. The position Director of Operations Paramedics \$1,545.00 bi-weekly shall be deleted.
- B. Training Officer/Paramedics \$1,472.00 bi-weekly shall be deleted.
- C. The position of Shift Lieutenant shall be added with the weekly pay of \$1,481.00 bi-weekly.


That all other provisions of Ordinance Number 3365 not hereinabove amended or changed shall remain in full force and effect.

Section II. REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section III. SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law, and shall be retroactive to January 1, 2004.
